
2nd Sunday of Ordinary Time (A)



- I waited, I waited for the Lord and he stooped <u>down</u> to me; he <u>heard</u> my cry. He put a new song in<u>to</u> my mouth, praise <u>of</u> our God. *R*
- 2. You delight not in sacrifice and offering, but in an open ear.
 You do not ask for holocaust and sin offering. Then I said, 'Behold, <u>I</u> have come.' *R*
- 3. In the scroll <u>of</u> the book
 it stands writ<u>ten</u> of me:
 'I delight to do your will, <u>O</u> my God;
 your instruction lies <u>deep</u> within me.' *R*
- 4. Your uprightness I <u>have</u> proclained in the <u>great</u> assembly. My lips I <u>have</u> not sealed; you know <u>it</u>, O Lord. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
