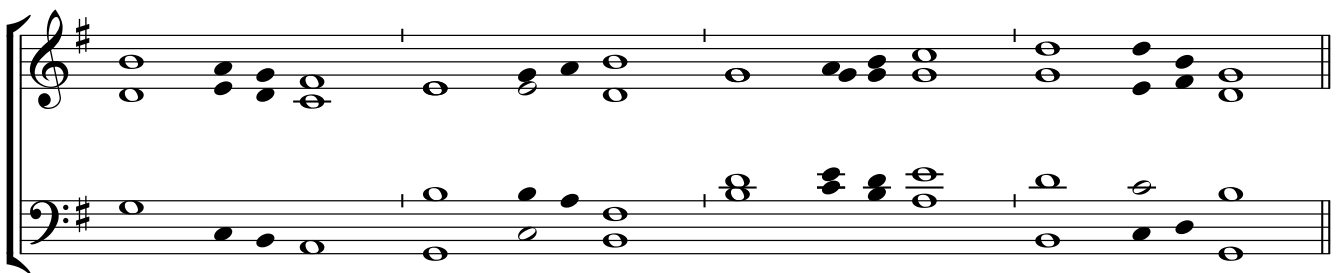
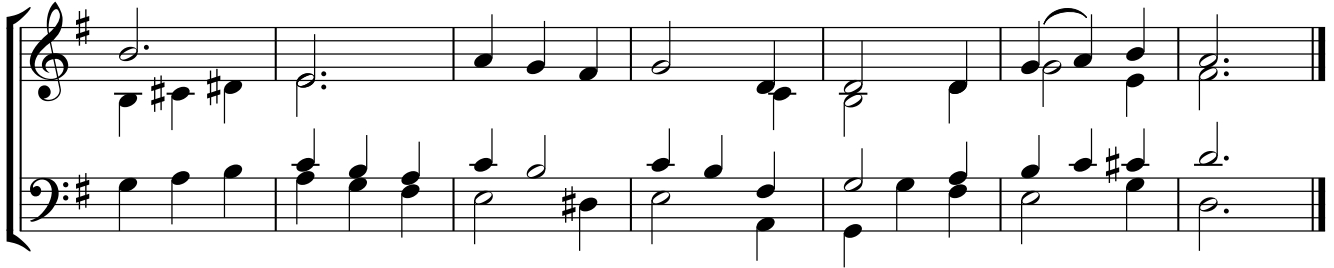


2nd Sunday of Ordinary Time (A)

1. I waited, I waited for the Lord and he stooped down to me;
he heard my cry.
He put a new song into my mouth,
praise of our God. *R*
2. You delight not in sacrifice and offering,
but in an open ear.
You do not ask for holocaust and sin offering.
Then I said, 'Behold, I have come.' *R*
3. In the scroll of the book
it stands written of me:
'I delight to do your will, O my God;
your instruction lies deep within me.' *R*
4. Your uprightness I have proclaimed
in the great assembly.
My lips I have not sealed;
you know it, O Lord. *R*

*The refrain is heard three times at the start:
first played on the organ,
then sung by the cantor and repeated by all;
it is then repeated after each verse.*
