
4th Sunday of Ordinary Time (A)

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 146:7-10. R. Mt 5:3

- It is the Lord who preserves fidelity forever, who does justice to those who <u>are</u> oppressed. It is he who gives bread <u>to</u> the hungry, the Lord who sets prisoners free. *R*
- 2. It is the Lord who opens the eyes <u>of</u> the blind, the Lord who raises up those who <u>are</u> bowed down. It is the Lord who pro<u>tects</u> the stranger and upholds the or<u>phan</u> and widow. *R*
- 3. It is the Lord who <u>loves</u> the just, but thwarts the path <u>of</u> the wicked. The Lord will <u>reign</u> for ever, Zion's God, from <u>age</u> to age. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
