
5th Sunday of Ordinary Time (A)



- A light rises in the darkness <u>for</u> the upright; he is generous, merci<u>ful</u> and just. It goes well for the good man who deals generous<u>ly</u> and lends, who conducts his af<u>fairs</u> with justice. *R*
- He will ne<u>ver</u> be moved; forever shall the upright <u>be</u> remembered. He has no fear of <u>e</u>vil news; with a firm heart, he trusts <u>in</u> the Lord. *R*
- With a steadfast heart he <u>will</u> not fear; openhanded, he gives <u>to</u> the poor; his justice stands <u>firm</u> for ever. His might shall be exalt<u>ed</u> in glory. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
