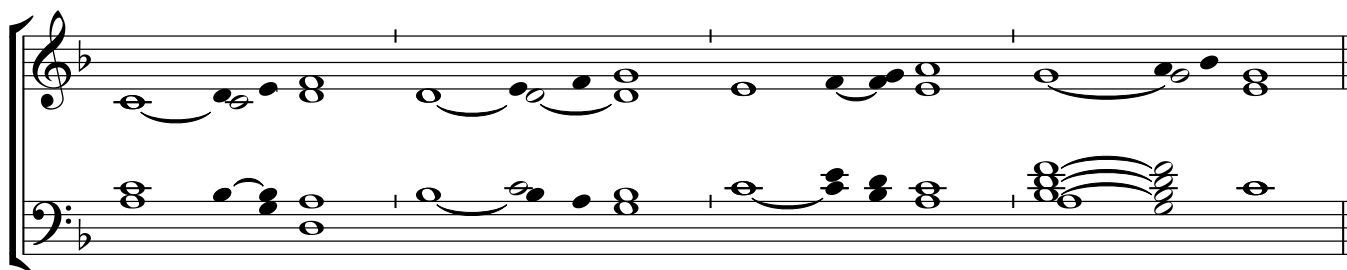
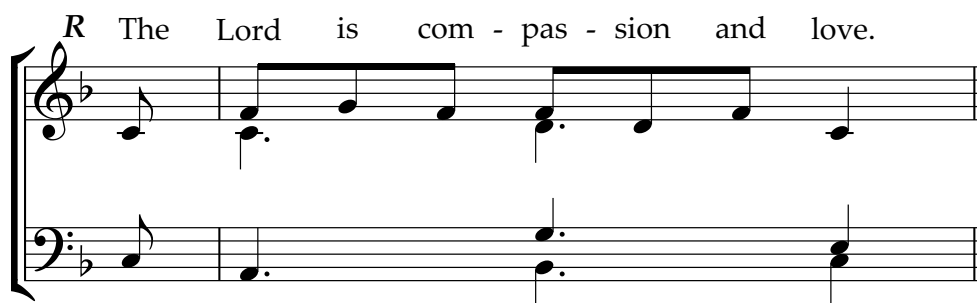


7th Sunday of Ordinary Time (A)

3. The Lord is compassionate and gracious,
slow to anger and rich in mercy.
He does not treat us according to our sins,
nor repay us according to our faults.. **R**
4. As far as the east is from the west,
so far from us does he remove our ttransgressions.
As a father has compassion on his children,
the Lord's compassion is on those who fear him. **R**
