
Ash Wednesday

Psalm 50, vv 3-6, 12-14, 17; refrain v 3

- 1. Have mercy on me, God, <u>in</u> your kindness. In your compassion blot out <u>my</u> offence. O wash me more and more <u>from</u> my guilt and cleanse me <u>from</u> my sin. *R*
- 2. My offences truly I know them; my sin is always before me. Against you, you alone, have I sinned; what is evil in your sight I have done. *R*
- 3. A pure heart create for <u>me</u>, O God, put a steadfast spi<u>rit</u> within me. Do not cast me away <u>from</u> your presence, nor deprive me of your <u>ho</u>ly spirit. *R*
- 4. Give me again the joy of your help. with a spirit of fervour sustain me, O Lord, open my lips and my mouth shall declare your praise. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all; it is then repeated by all after each verse.
