## 1st Sunday of Advent (A)

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 121:1-2, 4-5, 6-9. R. cf. v. 1


1. I rejoiced when they said to me, 'Let us go to the house of the Lord.' And now our feet are standing within your gates, $\underline{O}$ Jerusalem. $\boldsymbol{R}$
2. It is there that the tribes go up, the tribes of the Lord. as it is decreed for Israel, to give thanks to the name of the Lord. $\quad \boldsymbol{R}$
3. For the peace of Jerusalem pray:
'May they prosper, those who love you'.
May peace abide in your walls, and security be in your towers. $\boldsymbol{R}$
4. For the sake of my family and friends, let me say: 'Peace upon you.'
For the sake of the house of the Lord, our God, I will seek good things for you. $\quad \boldsymbol{R}$

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
