
5th Sunday of Lent (A)

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 130. R. v. 7

- Out of the depths I cry to <u>you</u>, O Lord; Lord, <u>hear</u> my voice! O let your ears <u>be</u> attentive to the sound <u>of</u> my pleading. *R*
- If you, O Lord, should mark <u>our</u> iniquities, Lord, <u>who</u> could stand?
 But with you is <u>found</u> forgiveness, that you may <u>be</u> revered. *R*
- I long for <u>you</u>, O Lord, my soul longs <u>for</u> his word. My soul a<u>waits</u> the Lord more than watch<u>men</u> for daybreak. *R*
- For with the Lord <u>there</u> is mercy, in him is plenti<u>ful</u> redemption.
 It is he who will redeem Israel from all <u>its</u> iniquities. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
