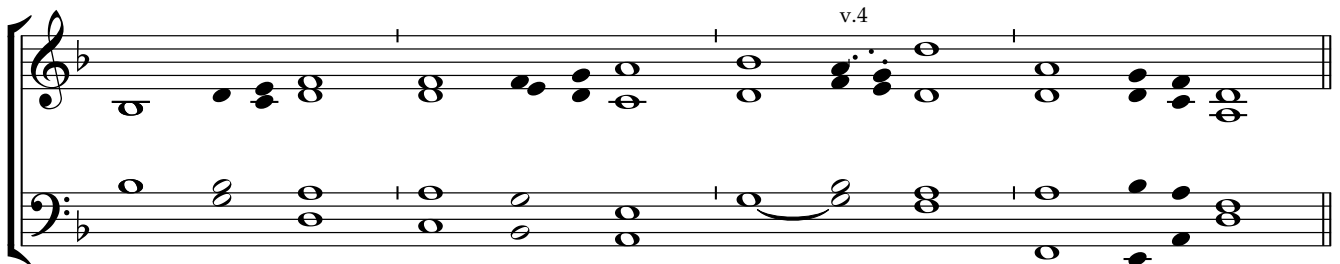
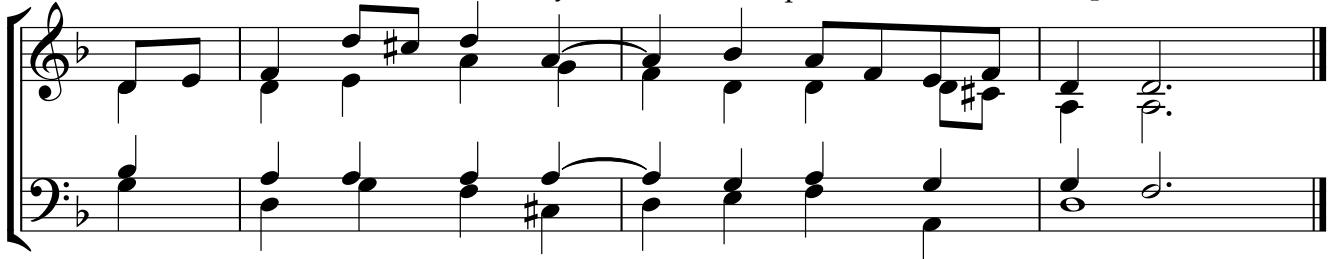


5th Sunday of Lent (A)

that you may be revered. **R**
3. I long for you, O Lord,
my soul longs for his word.
My soul awaits the Lord
more than watchmen for daybreak. **R**
4. For with the Lord there is mercy,
in him is plentiful redemption.
It is he who will redeem Israel
from all its iniquities. **R**

*The refrain is heard three times at the start:
first played on the organ,
then sung by the cantor and repeated by all;
it is then repeated after each verse.*
