

Passion Sunday (A, B, C)

- All who see me deride me; they curl their lips, they toss their heads: 'He trusted in the Lord, let him save him; let him release him, for in him he delights.' R
- They divide my clothing among them, they cast lots for my robe.
 But you, O Lord, do not stay afar off; my strength, make haste to help me! R
- For dogs <u>have</u> surrounded me;
 a band of the wick<u>ed</u> besets me.
 They tear holes in my hands <u>and</u> my feet;
 I can count ev'ry one <u>of</u> my bones. *R*
- 4. I will tell of your name to my kin, and praise you in the midst of <u>the</u> assembly. 'You who fear the Lord <u>give</u> him praise; all sons of Jacob, <u>give</u> him glory; revere him, all you descen<u>dants</u> of Israel'. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
