
Easter Sunday

Psalm 117, vv 1-2, 16-17, 22-23; refrain v 24

- 1. Give thanks to the Lord for <u>he</u> is good, for his love <u>has</u> no end. Let the sons of <u>Is</u>rael say: 'His love <u>has</u> no end.' *R*
- 2. The Lord's right <u>hand</u> has triumphed; His right hand has <u>raised</u> me up. I shall not die, <u>I</u> shall live and recount his deeds. *R*
- 3. The stone which the build<u>ers</u> rejected has become the <u>cornerstone</u>. This is the work <u>of</u> the Lord, a marvel <u>in</u> our eyes. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all; it is then repeated by all after each verse.
