
## 5th Sunday of Easter (A)



- Ring out your joy to the Lord, <u>O</u> you just; for praise is fitting from the upright. Give thanks to the Lord upon the harp, with a ten-stringed lute <u>sing</u> him songs. *R*
- 2. For the word of the Lord is upright, and all his works to be trusted.The Lord loves justice and right and his merciful love <u>fills</u> the earth. *R*
- 3. Yes, the Lord's eyes are on those who fear him, who hope in his merciful love, to rescue their soul from death, to keep them alive in famine. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
