
## 2nd Sunday of Advent (A)

**Responsorial Psalm**: Psalm 72:1-2, 7-8, 12-13, 17. R.cf.v.7

- 1. O God, give your judgement <u>to</u> the king, to a king's <u>son</u> your justice, that he may judge your peo<u>ple</u> in justice and your poor <u>in</u> right judgement. *R*
- In his days justice shall fourish and great peace till the moon fails.
   He shall rule from sea to sea, from the River to the bounds of the earth. R
- 3. For he shall rescue the needy <u>when</u> they cry, the poor who have no <u>one</u> to help.

  He will have pity on the weak <u>and</u> the needy and save the lives <u>of</u> the poor. *R*
- 4. May his name en<u>dure</u> forever, his name continue <u>like</u> the sun. Every tribe shall be <u>blest</u> in him, all nations shall <u>call</u> him blessed. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
