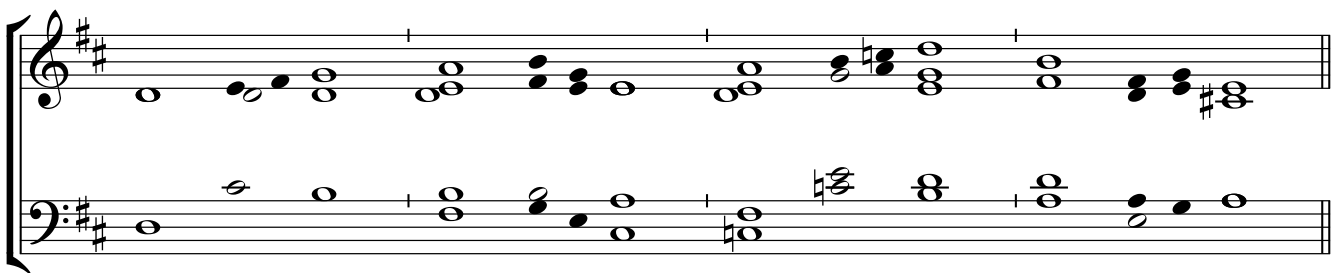
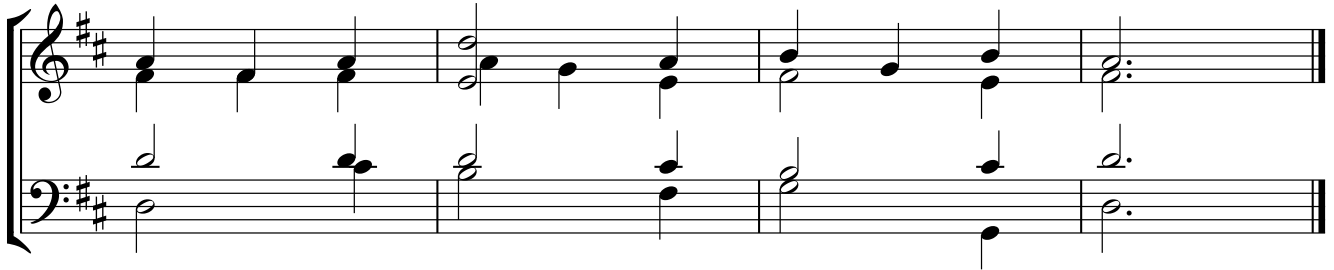


6th Sunday of Easter (A)

R Cry out with joy to God, all the earth.



1. Cry out with joy to God all the earth;
O sing to the glory of his name.
O render him glorious praise.
Say to God, 'How wondrous your deeds!' R
2. 'Before you all the earth shall bow down,
shall sing to you, sing to your name!'
Come and see the works of God:
his wondrous deeds among the children of Adam. R
3. He turned the sea into dry land;
they passed through the river on foot.
Let our joy, then, be in him;
he rules forever by his might. R
4. Come and hear, all who fear God;
I will tell what he did for my soul.
Blest be God who did not reject my prayer
nor withhold from me his merciful love. R

first played on the organ,
then sung by the cantor and repeated by all;
it is then repeated after each verse.*
