

## 6th Sunday of Easter (A)

**Responsorial Psalm**: Psalm 66: 1-7, 16, 20. R. v. 1

- Cry out with joy to God <u>all</u> the earth;
   O sing to the glory <u>of</u> his name.
   O render him <u>glor</u>ious praise.
   Say to God, 'How won<u>drous</u> your deeds!' *R*
- 'Before you all the earth <u>shall</u> bow down, shall sing to you, sing <u>to</u> your name!'
   Come and see the <u>works</u> of God: his wondrous deeds among the chil<u>dren</u> of Adam. *R*
- 3. He turned the sea into dry land; they passed through the river on foot. Let our joy, then, be in him; he rules forever by his might. *R*
- Come and hear, all who fear God;
   I will tell what he did for my soul.
   Blest be God who did not reject my prayer nor withhold from me his merciful love. R

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
