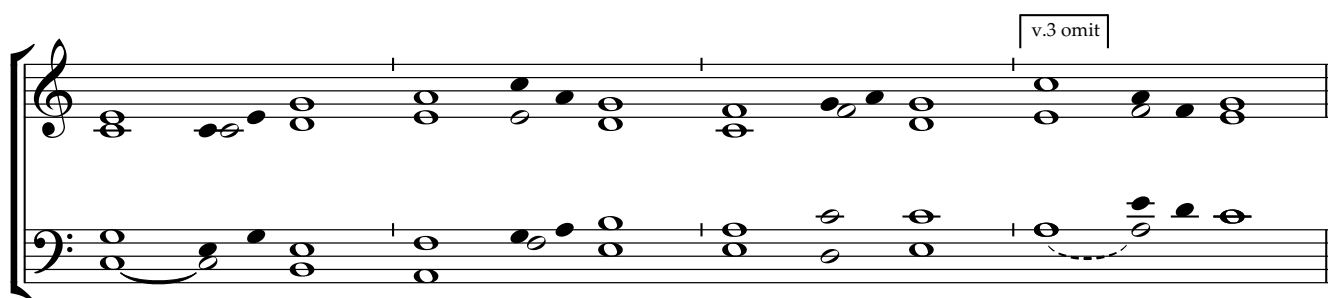


7th Sunday of Easter (A)

first played on the organ,
then sung by the cantor and repeated by all;
it is then repeated after each verse.*
