- There is one thing I ask of the Lord, only this <u>do</u> I seek, to live in the house of the Lord all the days <u>of</u> my life, to gaze on the beauty <u>of</u> the Lord, to inquire <u>at</u> his temple. *R*
- 3. O Lord, hear my voice <u>when</u> I call; have mercy and <u>answer me</u>.
 Of you my <u>heart</u> has spoken:
 'Seek his face.' *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
