

The Most Holy Trinity (A)

 Blessed are you on the throne <u>of</u> your kingdom, to be praised and highly exalt<u>ed</u> forever. *R*
- 3. Blessed are you who look into the depths, to be praised and highly exalted forever.

 Blessed are you in the firmament of heaven, worthy of praise and highly exalted forever. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
