
## SS Peter & Paul

Psalm 33, vv 1-8; refrain v 4

- 1. I will bless the Lord <u>at</u> all times, His praise always <u>on</u> my lips; in the Lord my soul shall <u>make</u> its boast. The humble shall hear <u>and</u> be glad. **R**
- Glorify the Lord with me.
  Together let us <u>praise</u> his name.
  I sought the Lord <u>and</u> he answered me; from all my terrors he <u>set</u> me free. *R*
- 3. Look towards him <u>and</u> be radiant; let not your faces <u>be</u> abashed. This poor man called; the <u>Lord</u> heard him and rescued him from all his distress. *R*
- 4. The angel of the Lord is encamped around those who revere him, to <u>res</u>cue them. Taste and see that the <u>Lord</u> is good. He is happy who seeks refuge in him. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all; it is then repeated by all after each verse.
