
## 13th Sunday of Ordinary Time (A)

- I will sing for ever of your mercies, O Lord; through all ages my mouth will proclaim <u>your</u> fidelity.
   I have declared your mercy is estab<u>lished</u> forever; your fidelity stands firm <u>as</u> the heavens. *R*
- 2. How blessed the people who <u>know</u> your praise, who walk, O Lord, in the light <u>of</u> your face, who find their joy every day <u>in</u> your name, who make your uprightness their joy<u>ful</u> acclaim. *R*
- 3. For you are the glory <u>of</u> their strength; by your favour it is that our might <u>is</u> exalted. Behold, the Lord <u>is</u> our shield; he is the Holy One of Is<u>rael</u>, our king. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
