
3rd Sunday of Advent (A)

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 145:6-10. R. cf. v. Isaiah 35:4

- It is the Lord who preserves fidelity forever, who does justice to those who are oppressed. It is he who gives bread to the hungry, the Lord who sets prisoners free. *R*
- 2 The Lord who opens the eyes <u>of</u> the blind, the Lord who raises up those who <u>are</u> bowed down. It is the Lord, who pro<u>tects</u> the stranger and upholds the orphan <u>and</u> the widow. *R*
- It is the Lord who <u>loves</u> the just but thwarts the path <u>of</u> the wicked. The Lord will <u>reign</u> forever, your God, O Zion, from <u>age</u> to age. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
