
14th Sunday of Ordinary Time (A)

- I will extol you, my <u>God</u> my King, I will bless your name forev<u>er</u> and ever. I will bless you day <u>after day</u> and praise your name forev<u>er</u> and ever. *R*
- The Lord is kind and full <u>of</u> compassion, slow to anger, abound<u>ing</u> in mercy. How good is the <u>Lord</u> to all, compassionate to <u>all</u> his creatures. *R*
- All your works shall thank <u>you</u>, O Lord, and all your faith<u>ful</u> ones bless you. They shall speak of the glory <u>of</u> your reign, and declare your <u>mighty</u> deeds. *R*
- 4. The Lord is faithful in <u>all</u> his words and holy in <u>all</u> his deeds. The Lord supports <u>all</u> who fall, and raises up all who <u>are</u> bowed down. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
