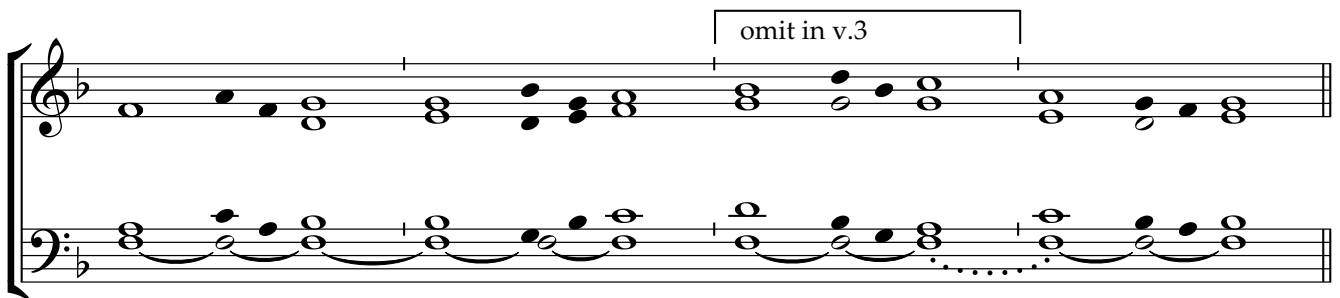
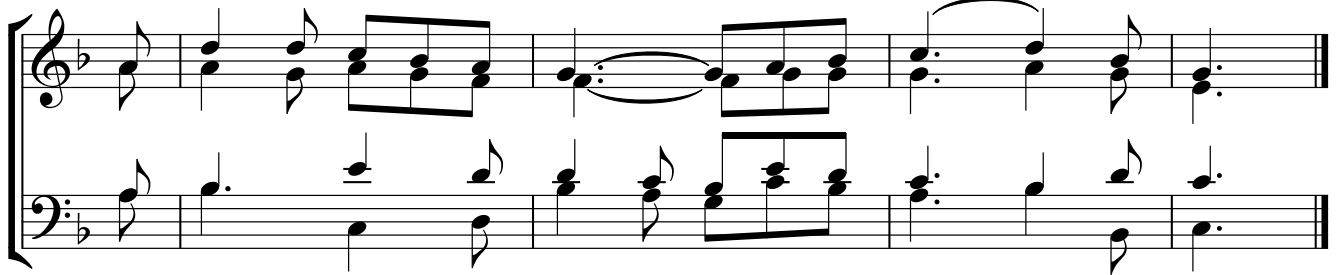


## 15th Sunday of Ordinary Time (A)
