
16th Sunday of Ordinary Time (A)

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 86: 5-6, 9-10, 15-16. R. v. 5

- O Lord, you are good <u>and</u> forgiving, full of mercy to <u>all</u> who call to you. Give ear, O Lord, <u>to</u> my prayer, and attend to my voice in <u>supp</u>lication. *R*
- 2. All the nations you have <u>made</u> shall come; they will bow down before you, O Lord, and glori<u>fy</u> your name, for you are great and do mar<u>vell</u>ous deeds, you who a<u>lone</u> are God. *R*
- 3. But you, O God, are compassion<u>ate</u> and gracious, slow to anger, O Lord, abundant in mercy <u>and</u> fidelity; turn and take pity on me. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
