

- I give thanks to your name for your merciful love and your faithfulness.
 On the day I called, you answered me; you increased the strength of my soul. R
- 3. The Lord is high, yet he looks on the lowly, and the haughty he knows from afar.O Lord, your merciful love is eternal; discard not the work of your hands. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
