
## 4th Sunday of Advent (A)

- 1. The Lord's is the earth <u>and</u> its fullness, the world, and those who <u>dwell</u> in it. It is he who set it <u>on</u> the seas; on the rivers he made it firm. *R*
- 2. Who shall climb the mountain of the Lord? Who shall stand by in his holy place? The clean of hands and pure of heart, whose soul is not set on vain things. *R*
- 3. Blessings from the Lord shall <u>he</u> receive, and right reward from the <u>God</u> who saves him. Such are the peo<u>ple</u> who seek him, who seek the face of the <u>God</u> of Jacob. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
