
## 24th Sunday of Ordinary Time (A)

- 3. He will not al<u>ways</u> find fault; nor persist in his anger for ever. He does not treat us according <u>to</u> our sins, nor repay us according <u>to</u> our faults. *R*
- 4. For as the heav'ns are high above the earth so strong is his love for those who fear him. As far as the east is from the west so far does he remove our transgressions. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
