

- 3. The Lord is just in <u>all</u> his ways and holy in <u>all</u> his deeds.The Lord is close to <u>all</u> who call him, who call on <u>him</u> in truth. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
