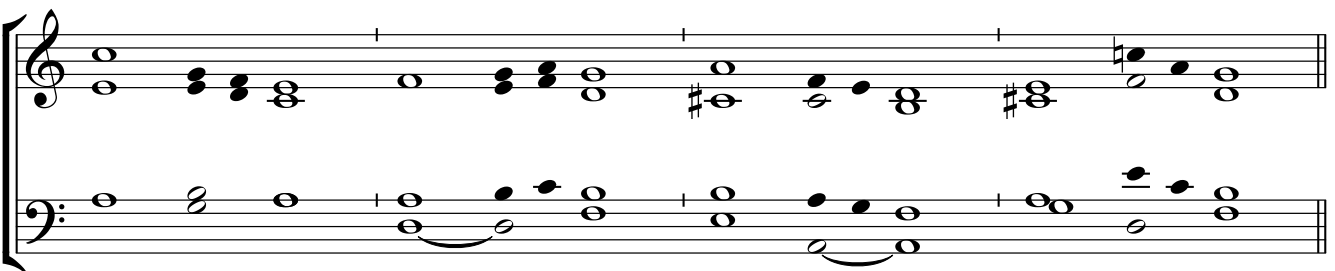
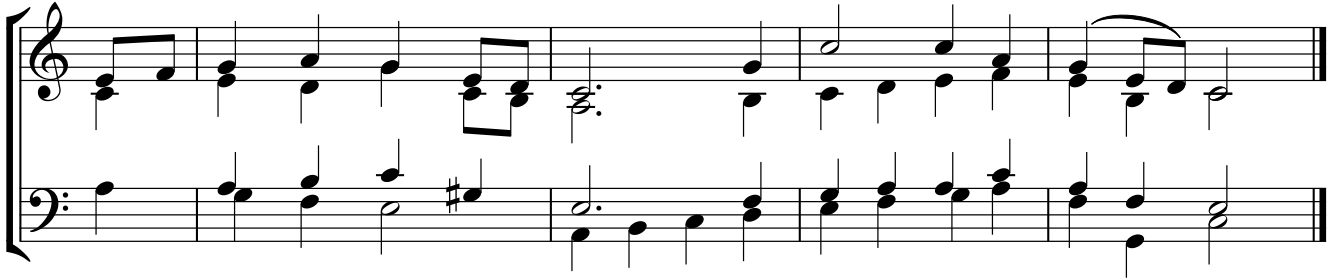


28th Sunday of Ordinary Time (A)
