
30th Sunday of Ordinary Time (A)

- 1. I love you, Lord, my strength, my rock, my fortress, my saviour; my God, my rock where I take refuge; my shield, my saving strength, my stronghold. I cry out, 'O praised be the Lord!' and see, I am saved from my foes. $\it R$
- 2. The Lord lives, and blest be my rock! May the God of my salvation be exalted. The Lord gives great victories to his king, and shows merciful love for his anointed, for David and his seed forever. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
