
All Saints

- 1. The earth is the Lord's <u>and</u> its fullness, the world and <u>all</u> its peoples. It is he who set it up<u>on</u> the seas; on the waters he <u>made</u> it firm. *R*
- 2. Who shall climb the mountain of the Lord? Who shall stand in his holy place? The man with clean hands and pure heart, who desires not worthless things. *R*
- 3. He shall receive blessings <u>from</u> the Lord and reward from the <u>God</u> who saves him. Sure are the <u>men</u> who seek him, seek the face of the God of Jacob. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all; it is then repeated by all after each verse.
