


## 32nd Sunday of Ordinary Time (A)

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 63:2-8. R. v 2

R For you my soul\_ is thirst - ing, O God, my God.



1. O God, you are my God; at dawn I seek you;  
for you my soul is thirsting.  
For you my flesh is pining,  
like a dry, dreary land without water. **R**
2. I have come before you in the sanctuary,  
to behold your strength and your glory.  
Your loving mercy is better than life,  
my lips will speak your praise. **R**
3. I will bless you all my life;  
in your name I will lift up my hands.  
My soul shall be filled as with a banquet;  
with joyful lips, my mouth shall praise you. **R**
4. For you have been my strength;  
in the shadow of your wings I rejoice.  
My soul clings fast to you;  
your right hand upholds me. **R**

*The refrain is heard three times at the start:  
first played on the organ,  
then sung by the cantor and repeated by all;  
it is then repeated after each verse.*
