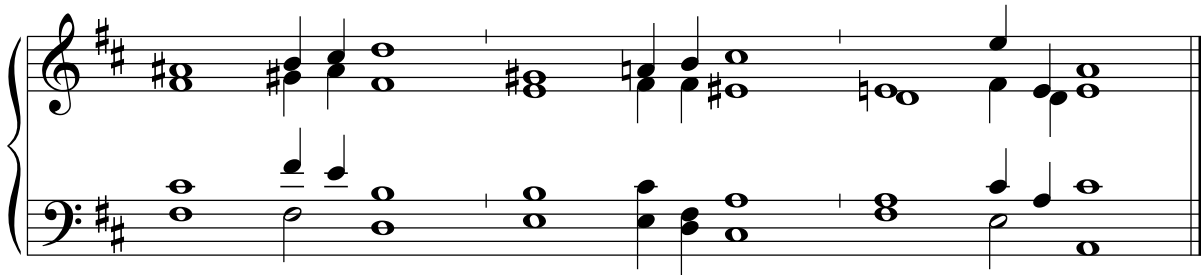
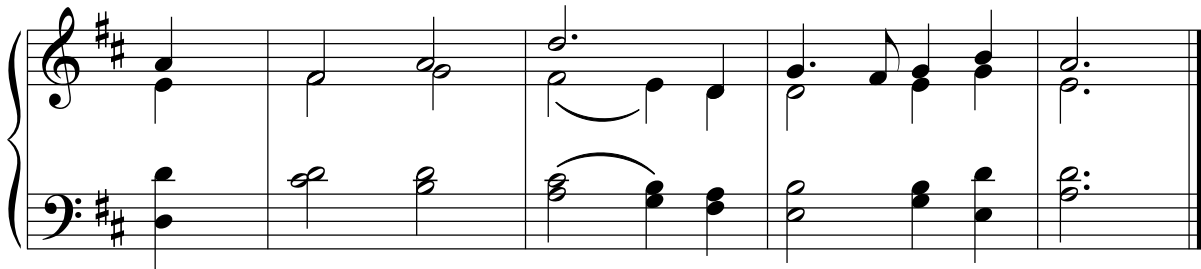


Last Sunday in Ordinary Time (B) Our Lord Jesus Christ, Universal King

1. The Lord is king, with majesty enrobed;
the Lord has enrobed himself with might,
he has girded himself with power. **R**

2. The world you made firm, not to be moved;
your throne has stood from of old.
From all eternity, O Lord, you are. **R**

3. Truly your decrees are to be trusted.
Holiness is fitting to your house,
O Lord, until the end of time. **R**

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all; it is then repeated by all after each verse.
