
Last Sunday in Ordinary Time (B) Our Lord Jesus Christ, Universal King

1. The Lord is king, with majesty enrobed; the Lord has enrobed himself with might, he has girded himself with power. R

2. The world you made firm, not <u>to</u> be moved; your throne has stood <u>from</u> of old. From all eternity, O <u>Lord</u>, you are. *R*

3. Truly your decrees are <u>to</u> be trusted. Holiness is fitting <u>to</u> your house, O Lord, until the <u>end</u> of time. R

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all; it is then repeated by all after each verse.
