

 a mighty stronghold to save me.

- Into your hands I com<u>mend</u> my spirit.
 You will redeem me, O Lord, O <u>faithful</u> God.
 As for me, I trust <u>in</u> the Lord.
 Let me be glad and rejoice <u>in</u> your mercy. *R*
- 3. But as for me, I trust in <u>you</u>, O Lord;
 I say, 'you are my God. There in your hands <u>is</u> my lot.
 Let your face shine <u>on</u> your servant.
 Save me in your mer<u>ci</u>ful love.' *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
