

# Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time (B)

Psalm 31, vv 1-2, 5, 11; refrain v 7

Robert Gower (b. 1952)

*R* You are my re-fuge, O Lord, you fill me with the joy, the joy — of sal - va - tion.

1. Happy the man whose offence is forgiv'n,  
whose sin is remitted.  
O happy the man to whom the Lord imputes no guilt,  
in whose spirit is no guile. *R*

2. But now I have acknowledged my sins;  
my guilt I did not hide.  
I said: 'I will confess my offence to the Lord.'  
And you, Lord, have forgiv'n the guilt of my sin. *R*

3. Rejoice, rejoice in the Lord,  
exult you just!  
O come, ring out your joy,  
all you upright of heart. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all; it is then repeated by all after each verse.
