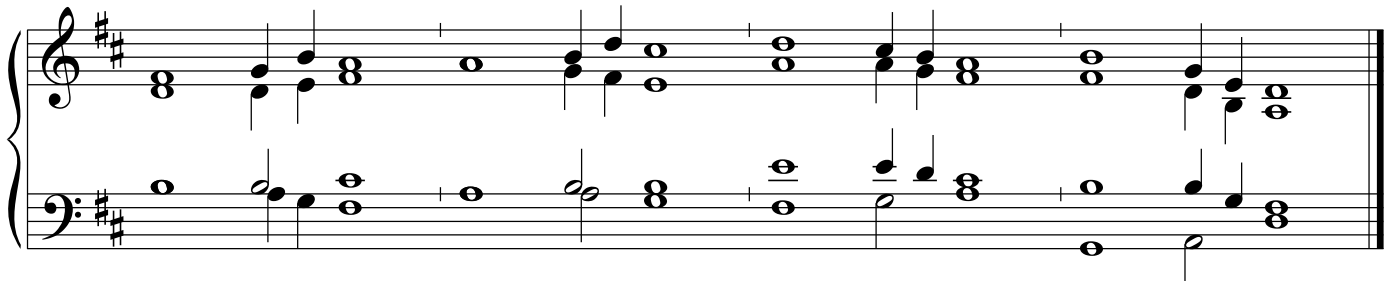
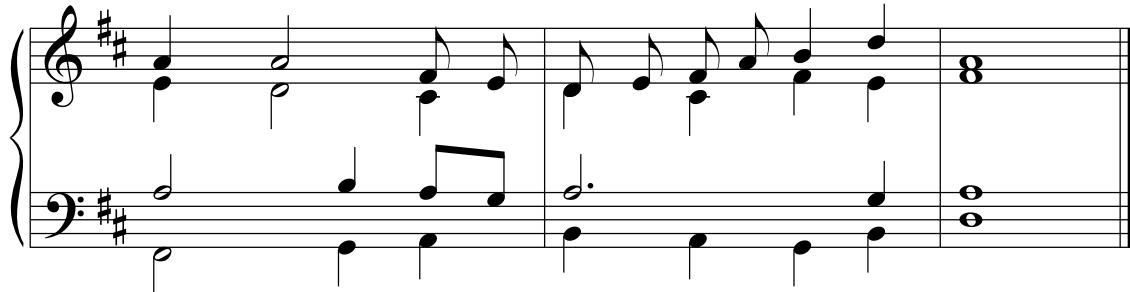


Third Sunday of Lent (B)

R You, Lord, have the mess-age of e - ter - nal life.



1. The law of the Lord is perfect,
it revives the soul.
The rule of the Lord is to be trusted,
it gives wisdom to the simple. **R**

2. The precepts of the Lord are right,
they gladden the heart.
The command of the Lord is clear,
it gives light to the eyes. **R**

3. The fear of the Lord is holy,
abiding for ever.
The decrees of the Lord are truth
and all of them just. **R**

4. They are more to be desired than gold,
than the purest of gold;
and sweeter are they than honey,
than honey from the comb. **R**

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all;
it is then repeated by all after each verse.
