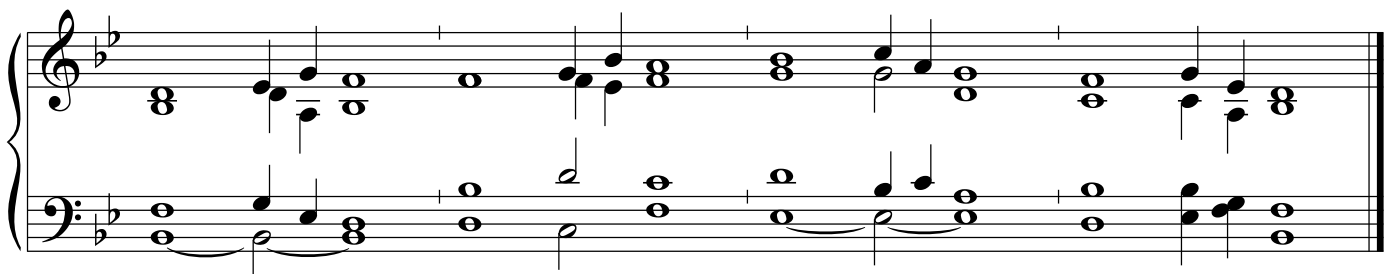
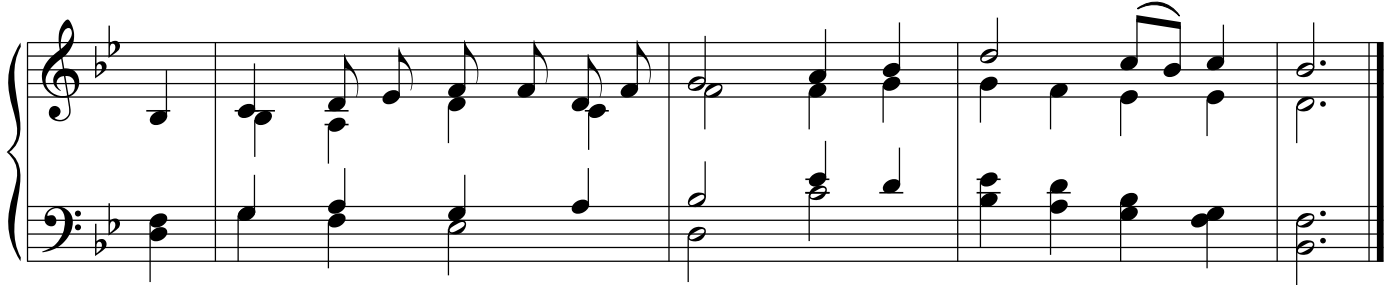


Second Sunday after Easter (B)

Psalm 117, vv 2-4, 15-18, 22-24; refrain v 1

R Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good, for his love has no end.



1. Let the sons of Israel say: 'his love has no end'.
Let the sons of Aaron say: 'his love has no end'.
Let those who fear the Lord say:
'his love has no end'. **R**

2. The stone which the builders rejected has become the cornerstone.
This is the work of the Lord, a marvel in our eyes.
This day was made by the Lord;
We rejoice and are glad. **R**

3. O Lord, grant us salvation; O Lord, grant success.
Blessed in the name of the Lord is he who comes.
We bless you from the house of the Lord;
The Lord God is our light. **R**

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all; it is then repeated by all after each verse.
