

# Third Sunday of Easter (B)

Psalm 4, vv 2, 4, 7, 9; refrain v 7

Robert Gower (b. 1952)

*R* Lift up the light of your face on us, O Lord.



1. When I call, answer me, O God of justice;  
from anguish you released me, have mercy and hear me!  
It is the Lord who grants favours to those whom he loves;  
the Lord hears me whenever I call him. **R**

2. 'What can bring us happiness?' many say.  
Lift up the light of your face on us, O Lord.  
I will lie in peace and sleep comes at once,  
for you alone, Lord, make me  dwell in safety. **R**

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all; it is then repeated by all after each verse.
