


# The Ascension of the Lord (B)


Psalm 46, vv 2-3, 6-9; refrain v 6

**R** God goes up with shouts of joy, the Lord goes up with trum - pet blast.

1. All peoples, clap your hands,  
cry to God with shouts of joy!  
For the Lord, the most high, we must fear,  
great King over all the earth. **R**

2. God goes up with shouts of joy;  
the Lord goes up with trumpet blast.  
Sing praise for God, sing praise,  
sing praise to our King, sing praise. **R**

3. God is the King of all the earth.  
Sing praise with all your skill.  
God is King over the nations;  
God reigns on his holy throne. **R**

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all; it is then repeated by all after each verse.
