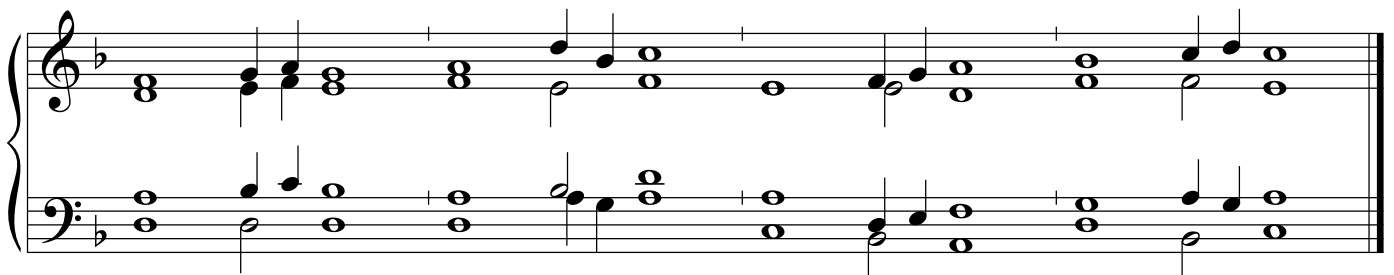
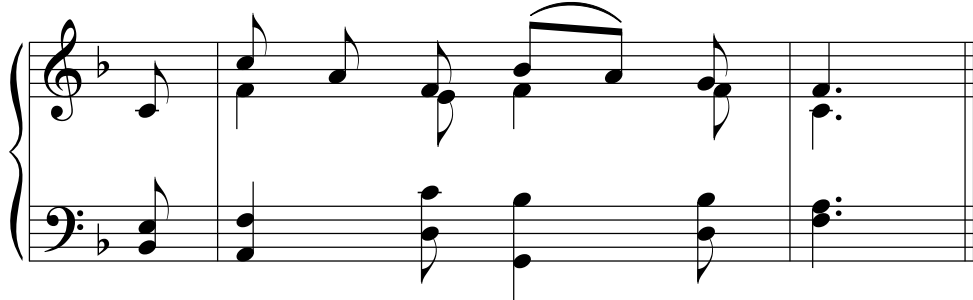


# 18th Sunday in Ordinary Time (B)

Psalm 77, vv 3-4, 23-25, 54; refrain v 24

*R* The Lord gave them bread\_\_ from heav'n.



1. The things we have heard and understood,  
the things our fathers have told us,  
we will tell to the next generation:  
the glories of the Lord and his might. *R*

2. He commanded the clouds above  
and opened the gates of heav'n.  
He rained down manna for their food,  
and gave them bread from heav'n. *R*

3. Mere men ate the bread of angels.  
He sent them abundance of food.  
He brought them to his holy land,  
to the mountain which his right hand had won. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all; it is then repeated by all after each verse.
