Psalm 89, vv 12-17; refrain v 14

*R* Fill us with your love, that we may re-joice.



1. Make us know the shortness of our life  
that we may gain wisdom of heart.  
Lord, relent! Is your anger for ever?  
Show pity to your servants. **R**

2. In the morning, fill us with your love;  
we shall rejoice and exult all our days.  
Give us joy to balance our affliction  
for the years when we knew misfortune. **R**

3. Show forth your work to your servants;  
let your glory shine on their children.  
Let the favour of the Lord be upon us;  
give success to the work of our hands. **R**

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all; it is then repeated by all after each verse.
