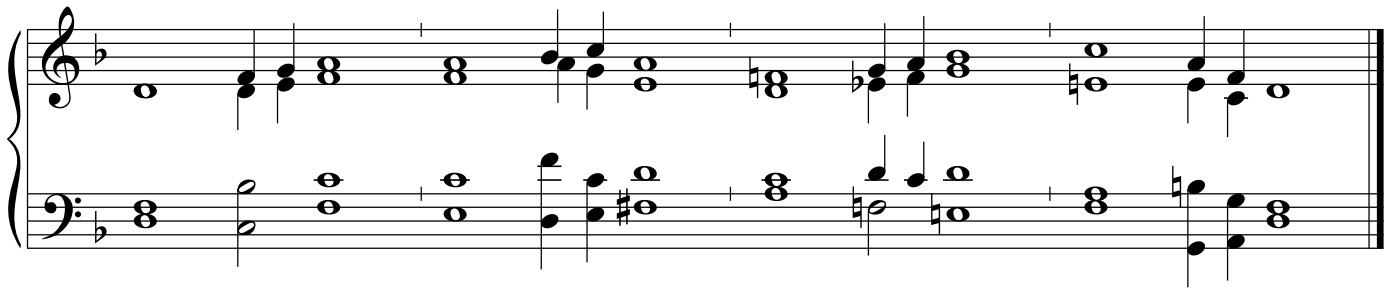
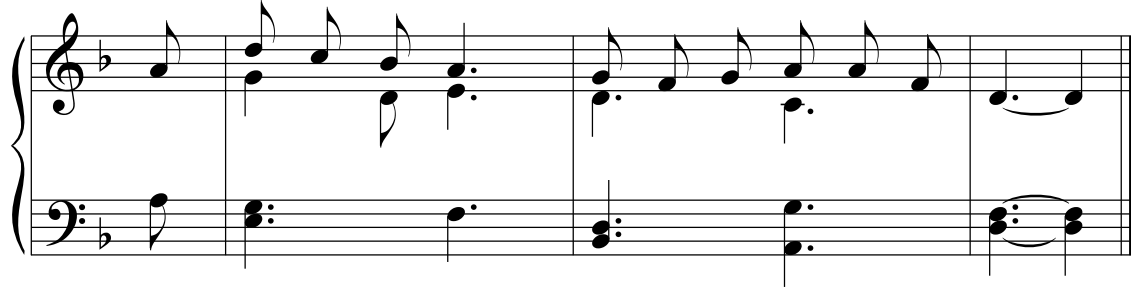


# Epiphany of our Lord (B)

Psalm 71, vv 1-2, 7-8, 10-13; refrain v 11

*R* All na - tions shall fall pros-trate be - fore you, O Lord. —



1. O God, give your judgement to the king,  
to a king's son your justice,  
that he may judge your people in justice  
and your poor in right judgement. *R*

2. In his days justice shall flourish  
and peace till the moon fails.  
He shall rule from sea to sea,  
from the great river to earth's bounds. *R*

3. The kings of Tarshish and the sea coasts shall pay him tribute.  
The kings of Sheba and Seba shall bring him gifts.  
Before him all kings shall fall prostrate.  
All nations shall serve him. *R*

4. For he shall save the poor when they cry  
and the needy who are helpless.  
He will have pity on the weak  
and save the lives of the poor. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all;  
it is then repeated by all after each verse.
