



2nd Sunday of Ordinary Time (C)

2. Proclaim his salvation day by day,
tell among the nations his glory
and his wonders among all the peoples. **R**
3. Ascribe to the Lord, you families of peoples,
ascribe to the Lord glory and power;
ascribe to the Lord the glory of his name. **R**
4. Worship the Lord in holy splendour. O tremble before him all the earth.
Say to the nations: "The Lord is king."
He will judge the peoples in fairness. **R**

first played on the organ,
then sung by the cantor and repeated by all;
it is then repeated after each verse.*
