
2nd Sunday of Ordinary Time (C)

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 95 (96): 1-3, 7-10. R. v. 3

- O sing a new song to the Lord, sing to the Lord <u>all</u> the earth.
 O sing to the Lord, <u>bless</u> his name. *R*
- Proclaim his salvation <u>day</u> by day, tell among the na<u>tions</u> his glory and his wonders among <u>all</u> the peoples. *R*
- 3. Ascribe to the Lord, you families of peoples, ascribe to the Lord glory and power; ascribe to the Lord the glory <u>of</u> his name. *R*
- 4. Worship the Lord in holy splendour. O tremble before him <u>all</u> the earth. Say to the nations: "The <u>Lord</u> is king." He will judge the peoples in fairness. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
