
3rd Sunday of Ordinary Time (C)

- 3. The fear of the <u>Lord</u> is pure, abiding for ever.The judgments of the <u>Lord</u> are true; they are, all <u>of</u> them, just. *R*
- 4. May the spoken words of my mouth, the thoughts of my heart, win favour in your sight, O Lord, my rock and my redeemer! **R**

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
