

- I thank you, Lord, with <u>all</u> my heart, you have heard the words <u>of</u> my mouth.
 In the presence of the angels I praise you.
 I bow down toward your <u>ho</u>ly temple. *R*
- I give thanks to your name for your mer<u>ciful</u> love.
 For you have exalted over all your name <u>and</u> your promise.
 On the day I called, you <u>an</u>swered me;
 you increased the strength <u>of</u> my soul. *R*
- 3. All earth's kings shall thank <u>you</u>, O Lord, when they hear the words <u>of</u> your mouth. They shall sing of the ways <u>of</u> the Lord, "How great is the glory <u>of</u> the Lord!" *R*
- With your right <u>hand</u> you save me,
 The Lord will accomplish <u>this</u> for me.
 O Lord, your merciful love <u>is</u> eternal;
 discard not the work <u>of</u> your hands. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
