


6th Sunday of Ordinary Time (C)

R Blessed the man who has placed his trust in the Lord.



1. Blessed indeed is the man who follows not the counsel of the wicked, nor stands in the path with sinners, nor abides in the company of scorners, but whose delight is in the law of the Lord and who ponders his law day and night. **R**
2. He is like a tree that is planted beside the flowing waters, that yields its fruit in due season and whose leaves shall never fade: and all that he does shall prosper. **R**
3. Not so are the wickeded, not so!
For they, like winnowed chaff shall be driven away by the wind.
For the Lord knows the way of the righteous,
but the way of the wickeded will perish. **R**

*The refrain is heard three times at the start:
first played on the organ,
then sung by the cantor and repeated by all;
it is then repeated after each verse.*
