
6th Sunday of Ordinary Time (C)

- 1. Blessed indeed is the man who follows not the counsel of the wicked, nor stands in the path with sinners, nor abides in the company of scorners, but whose delight is in the law of the Lord and who ponders his law day and night. *R*
- 2. He is like a tree that is planted beside the <u>flowing</u> waters, that yields its fruit <u>in</u> due season and whose leaves shall <u>ne</u>ver fade: and all that he <u>does</u> shall prosper. **R**
- 3. Not so are the wick<u>ed</u>, not so!

 For they, like winnowed chaff shall be driven away <u>by</u> the wind.

 For the Lord knows the way <u>of</u> the righteous,
 but the way of the wick<u>ed</u> will perish. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
