

- 1. It is good to give thanks to the Lord, to make music to your name, O Most High, to proclaim your loving mercy in the morning and your truth in the watches of the night. **R**
- 2. The just one will flourish <u>like</u> the palm tree and grow like a Lebanon cedar. *R*
- 3. Planted in the house of the Lord, they will flourish in the courts of our God, still bearing fruit when they are old, still full of sap, still green, to proclaim that the Lord is upright, in him, my rock there is no wrong. **R**

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
